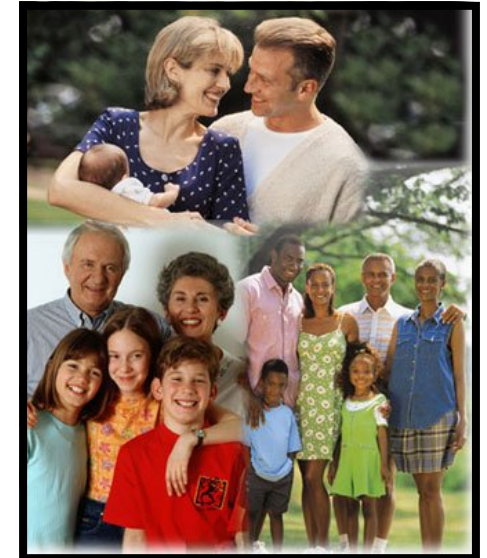

## What is Intensive Family Interventions ?

PMC, LLC., Counseling and Advocacy Services Intensive Family Intervention Program is designed to improve family functioning by stabilizing living arrangements, promoting reunification when clinically proven appropriate and/or preventing the use of out of home therapeutic resources or placement services.



The services provided are primarily to youths ages 6-22 years old who have a diagnosed serious emotional disorders and/or substance related disorders.

Services are family-focused, active, and rehabilitative; delivered primarily in the individual's home or other natural locations in the community, i.e. schools, or group homes. Services may also be delivered in the PMCCAS office. Services are initiated where there is a reasonable likelihood that such services will lead to specific, observable improvements in the consumer's functioning.

All IFI Services are based upon a thorough comprehensive assessment and treatment lasts for a minimum Of 90 days.



We focus on how to:

- Diffuse any current crisis, evaluate its nature and intervene to reduce the likelihood of recurrence
- Ensure the linkage to needed community services and resources
- Insure the clinical appropriateness of services provided
- Improve youths' ability to care for self if developmentally appropriate and their parent's or legal guardian's capacity to care for them.
- Intensive treatment at the beginning, and decrease over time as the individual or family's strengths and coping skills develop. Flexible services are designed to address concrete therapeutic and environmental issues in order to stabilize a crisis or immediate situations as soon as possible.
